

堀文庫

島根県津和野町の堀幸清氏の旧蔵書である堀文庫は、1,818 冊に及ぶ江戸小説のコレクションで、主に「読本(よみほん)」(版本)と「実録」(写本)からなる。堀家は江戸時代初期から大規模な鉱山経営を展開し、明治以降、地元の殖産・教育等に尽力したことで知られる。堀文庫の書籍群は、江戸から明治期にかけて津和野で営業した貸本屋で使用された書籍で、何らかの経緯で堀家に伝えられたものである。特定の貸本屋の書籍がこれほどまとまって残る例は少なく、貴重である。



Hori Collection

Hori Collection consists of novels created in the Edo period, 1818 books in total, collected by Hori Yoshikiyo (Tsuwanocho, Shimane). Most of the collection consists of "Yomi-Hon" (Printed Book) and "Jitsuroku" (Manuscript Copy). Hori family is renowned for its large scale of a mining management in early Edo period, and they contributed to the local industries and education. Books in Hori Collection were used in a book-lending shop which did business in Tsuwanocho from the Edo period to the Meiji era and the collection was given to Hori family. It is rare that such a big number of books, held by a book-lending shop, were left together.
