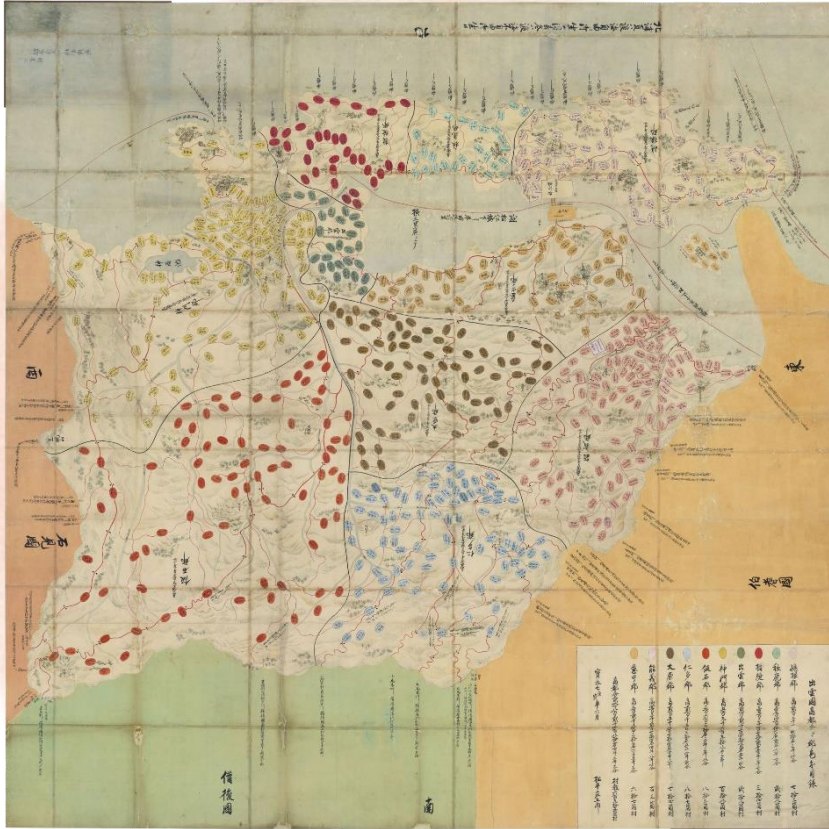


元禄出雲国絵図

元禄15（1702）年に幕府に収蔵された国絵図の原本は残っていないが、平成10（1998）年になって、松江市内で原図と推定される絵図が見つかった。本館で所蔵している絵図は平成21（2009）年に古書店から購入したもので、原図からの写本と考えられる。元禄期の出雲が正確に描写されており、絵図の右下に、郡ごとの村数、石高とともに、松平庄五郎（松江藩第5代藩主、松平出羽守宣維）の名が明記されている。

The Tokugawa shogunate government ordered every daimyo (feudal lord) to prepare maps of each province. In the province of Izumo, Matsudaira Yoshito prepared the original map in 1701 and carried that to Edo, where the painter designated by the shogunate government made a copy of the original map. The copy was presented to the shogunate government, but it has been lost. However, the map which is presumed to be the original map was found in 1998. Shimane University Library holds a map presumed to be another copy of the original map, which is purchased from a secondhand bookstore in 2009. It correctly describes the Izumo province in Genroku period, and the number of villages in each district, rice yield and the name of Matsudaira Shogoro: the 5th feudal lord of Matsue, Matsudaira (Dewanokami) Nobusumi are written.
